

BYLAW NO. 7/92


A BYLAW WITH RESPECT TO LIVE STOCK AND POULTRY

The council of the Town of Rouleau, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


1. No person shall herd cattle at any time within the limits of the town.
2. No person shall graze cattle, nor shall any cattle be permitted to graze at any time within the limits of the town.
3. No person shall keep horses, cattle or other livestock, poultry, pigeons, foxes, mink, rabbits, or any animals reared for the bearing of fur at any time within the limits of the town.
4. Any person who contravenes any provisions of this bylaw of the Town of Rouleau is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction.
5. Bylaw P 8/75 is hereby repealed
