

ROULEAU RINK REOPENING GUIDELINES – (AS OF NOV 4/2020)

The Rouleau Curling & Skating Club will follow COVID-19 guidelines determined by Saskatchewan Health Authority, Saskatchewan Hockey Assoc. and the Rouleau Rink Board.

The situation with COVID-19 is fluid and ever-changing. Users of the Rouleau Curling & Skating Club MUST adhere to the rules put out by the Rouleau Rink Board. These MAY include, but are NOT limited to: Social distancing, Mask wearing, Washing/Sanitizing of hands, Limiting number of spectators, and Limiting access to certain areas.

*All COVID-19 policies are subject to change, based on directives from Saskatchewan Health Authority.

APPLICABLE TO ALL USERS (TEAMS & SPECTATORS)

- Rouleau Curling & Skating Club has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of Covid-19 and common areas will be sanitized periodically. We cannot guarantee that anyone who enters the facility will not become infected with COVID-19. All patrons who enter the facility are entering at their own risk.
- Anyone who has Covid-19 or flu-like symptoms such as: **any new or worsening symptoms (of any severity) that may include one or more of the following:**
Cough, Runny Nose, Sore Throat, Flu-like Symptoms, Shortness of Breath, Muscle Aches or Joint Pain, Fatigue or Fever (38°C or 100.4°F) must follow the Sask Health Authority protocols and MUST NOT enter the facility.
- Masks are REQUIRED for all users that enter the facility. ALL Players MUST wear their masks until they are ready to put on their helmet, as per Sask Hockey Assoc. rules.
- **Social Distance Viewing** will be marked. Please use **ONLY** these areas.
- Sanitizer stations will be placed in the entrance and lobby. Use them when entering, exiting and during your time in the facility.
- The main washrooms, off the lobby, will be open for public use and will be cleaned often.
- The kitchen is CLOSED, there is a vending machine for drinks and snacks, cash only.
- Please use the parking lot on the east side of the building.

SPECTATORS

- **LIMITED TO 1 PARENT/GUARDIAN PER PLAYER. Siblings are not permitted, no exceptions. Coaches, Scorekeepers and Timekeepers are not counted as parent spectators.** If a player's parent is volunteering in one of these positions, they can have another parent/guardian come as a spectator.
- Spectator areas will be marked. Use **ONLY** the seating/standing areas specifically allocated for practices and games. (reason is cleaning cost & time)
- **SPECTATOR AREA DURING PRACTICES:**
 1. **THE MAIN LOBBY (MARKED SPOTS)**
- **SPECTATOR AREAS DURING GAMES: (HOME/VISITOR COMBINED), IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS:**
 1. **THE MAIN LOBBY (20 MARKED SPOTS)**
 2. **VIEWING WINDOWS TO THE LEFT OF THE ENTRANCE (4 SPOTS)**
 3. **STANDING AREAS IN OUTSIDE NORTH STANDS (4 SPOTS)**
 4. **THE UPPER "MEZZANINE" (8 SPOTS. TO BE USED ONLY WHEN NECESSARY, FOR TEAMS WITH LARGER NUMBERS OF PLAYERS)**

TEAM INFO

- Each group will be required to keep a log of EVERY PERSON who attended with their team. This will be required for EACH DATE you are in the facility. These lists MUST be retained (MINIMUM 30 DAYS), *by their respective teams*, in case a situation arises where we have to provide user lists for contact tracing purposes (as per Sask Hockey Assoc. Return to Hockey safety guidelines).
- You MUST NOT arrive more than **15 MINUTES** prior to your **PRACTICE** ice time, and MUST leave within 15 MINUTES of the practice ending.
- You MUST NOT arrive more than **30 MINUTES** prior to your **GAME** ice time, and MUST leave within 15 MINUTES of the game ending.
- Come as dressed as is possible.
- For **PRACTICES**, follow signage to dressing area. (non-local teams only)
- For **GAMES**, each team will be assigned 2 dressing rooms. 8 PERSON MAXIMUM per dressing room. Distancing will be marked.
- Dressing Room #1 will be available for a **female** change room. **Max capacity of 5 people.**
- **Dressing Room showers will be CLOSED.** Dressing Room washrooms will be cleaned between groups, please use only if necessary.
- Please limit the number of items brought into the facility to only what is necessary for your practice/game and be sure to take all of your belongs with you.
- Absolutely **no spitting** in the facility or on the ice surface.
- **It will be up to all teams to ensure their players/parents/coaches are following all COVID-19 guidelines, both on and off ice.**

FAILURE TO FOLLOW GUIDELINES AND POLICIES

The Rouleau Rink Board recognizes these guidelines may pose challenges and inconveniences, and may differ from other facilities. However, following these guidelines is the ONLY way we can remain open this season and provide a facility for your children to use.
